

Dumfries and Galloway Housing Partnership Assurance Statement 2019

As required by the Scottish Housing Regulator, Dumfries and Galloway Housing Partnership (DGHP) has produced the following statement of assurance on the organisation's compliance with regulatory requirements.

- 1. To the best of the Board's knowledge, DGHP materially complies with all the regulatory requirements set out in Chapter 3 of the Regulatory Framework, except as noted below.
- 2. We confirm that we comply with all of the standards and outcomes in the Scottish Social Housing Charter for tenants, people who are homeless and others who use our services.
