The Scottish Housing Regulator asked landlords to confirm whether they meet all duties in relation to tenant and resident safety, and in particular that they have obtained appropriate assurance about their compliance with electrical safety, asbestos, damp and mould, fire safety, gas safety, lift safety and water safety.

East Ayrshire have robust arrangements in place to monitor and review areas associated with our tenant's safety to ensure compliance.
