ANNUAL ASSURANCE STATEMENT 2019

Based on our self-assessment of compliance and associated evidence, we comply with all but one of the regulatory requirements set out in the Regulatory Framework, i.e.:

- Landlords must collect data relating to each of the protected characteristics for their existing tenants, new tenants, people on waiting lists, governing body members and staff. Local authorities must also collect data on protected characteristics for people who apply to them as homeless. Landlords who provide Gypsy / Traveller sites must collect data on protected characteristics for these service users

East Ayrshire Council currently only collects data in relation to disability and ethnic origin of tenants, which is submitted as part of the ARC. The Council are working towards collecting data relating to all of the protected characteristics of the above groups to comply with this regulatory requirement by April 2021, i.e. when the SHR will begin to measure compliance with this requirement.
