ANNUAL ASSURANCE STATEMENT

We, the Harbour Homes Board of Management, confirm that we comply with the regulatory requirements set out in Chapter 3 of the Scottish Housing Regulator's Framework.

This includes:

- The relevant standards and outcomes of the Scottish Social Housing Charter
- All relevant statutory and legal obligations and
- The Regulatory Standards of Governance and Financial Management

Supporting Evidence

The evidence bank combines reports, policies, advice and information which the Board monitors and oversees on an ongoing basis throughout the year to provide continuous evidence that Harbour Homes is compliant. This includes:

- Regular reports about key performance information
- Internal and External Audit reports
- Outcomes of tenant consultation exercises
- Benchmarking
- Reports, advice and information from senior staff

Tenant and Resident Safety

We confirm that we meet all duties in relation to tenant and resident safety with the exception of Electrical Safety.

Areas for Improvement

As at 31 March we had 313 properties which do not have valid Electrical Installation Condition Reports (EICRs). We have consulted our solicitors and are in the process of updating our policy to allow for forced entries for EICRs and LD2 installations to begin in Autumn 2023. We continue to synchronise access with other safety inspections, planned and responsive works wherever possible. We anticipate a significant improvement in the performance against both Element 11: Electrical installations and Element 45: Safe electrical systems in 2024/25.
