Why we are engaging with Scottish Borders Council (Scottish Borders)
We are engaging with Scottish Borders about its site for Gypsy/Travellers.

Scottish Borders expects to be compliant, by June 2019, with the Scottish Government's minimum standards for its Gypsy/Traveller site. The deadline for compliance was June 2018.

What Scottish Borders must do

We expect Scottish Borders to provide us with information about its progress in meeting the minimum standards for its Gypsy/Traveller site.

What we will do

We will:

- monitor Scottish Borders' compliance with Gypsy/Traveller site standards; and
- we will review Scottish Borders' services for people who are homeless with a particular focus on the following area when we receive the Scottish Government's 2018/19 national homelessness statistics and the Annual Returns on the Charter - outcomes for people who are homeless in relation to the percentage of unintentionally homeless people Scottish Borders did not know the outcome for.

Regulatory returns

Scottish Borders must provide us with the following annual regulatory returns:

- Annual Assurance statement; and
- Annual Return on the Charter.

It should also notify us of any material changes to its Annual Assurance Statement, and any tenant and resident safety matter which has been reported to or is being investigated by the Health and Safety Executive or reports from regulatory or statutory authorities or insurance providers, relating to safety concerns.
